THERE WILL BE FOUR CASH AWARDS, ONE PER CATEGORY:

POETRY (Rhymed and Unrhymed) 50 lines maximum.

Rhymed includes internal and end rhymes in traditional forms such as couplets, sonnets, villanelles, etc.

Unrhymed includes blank verse, free verse, prose poems, haiku, senryu, etc.

PROSE (Non-fiction & Short Fiction) 2500 words maximum.

Non-fiction can be true personal essays, opinion pieces, blog posts/columns, articles and feature stories.

Fiction must be tales in the genre of author's choice (mystery, western, confession, romance, sci-fi).
